## Portfolio Rubric

Portfolio 75 points	- Consists of strong pieces that follows NYC DOE REQUIREMENTS, submits more than the required #, depending on CTE Major selected. Follows all portfolio requirements, excelling the basic quality requirements listed on our website, hsfi.nyc	- Follows the NYC DOE portfolio requirements but has submitted less than the required # (75%). Quality meets the basic requirements listed on our website, hsfi.nyc	- Portfolio shows artistic potential but does not follow the NYC DOE portfolio requirements in regards to number of pieces submitted (50%) and/or the basic requirements. Quality shows promise.	- Makes little or no attempt to follow the portfolio guidelines. Overall portfolio is disorganized, demonstrating very little effort.
